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3. TSi development role	Jane to ask Elidh to meet with Willie Findlay and Stewart Lamberton, to take forward the TSI development role. Stewart is the Partnership Officer for Child Protection and has a link with Taxi drivers.	JM

To consider fully in April meeting how to progress work that was to be undertaken by Health Improvement post, and whether to go ahead with that recruitment or alternative post, Paul, Jane, Ali, and Joyce to discuss. Susan is concerned about the impact on ICS, but said that she recognised biggest gap was in operational work and that the role of family support workers and Lloyds funded Arrows service should be clarified.	
5. Quality Principles Inspection	Quality Principles Inspection discussed. To identify ASAP 10 files, and to pull them together. Susan suggested that Paul link in with Jen O'Hagan who has done some work with CARE Inspectorate. Jane will also try and get some temporary support for Paul to organise the Inspection.
